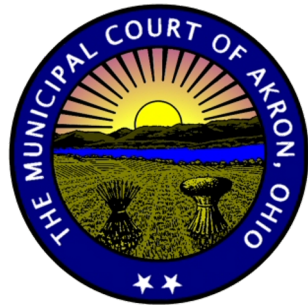

## AND OTHER PROGRAMMING

### Specialized Docket: Family Intervention Court

Led by Judge Ron Cable

*Targets domestic violence offenders and is a therapeutic alternative to traditional court practices*

### Specialized Docket: OVI Court

Led by Judge Nicole Walker

*Post-plea, voluntary program that allows defendants to work toward abstinence from alcohol and drugs*

### Specialized Docket: Recovery Court

Led by Judge Jon Oldham

*Oversees drug abuse offenders and addresses the disease of addiction by merging treatment with accountability*

### Specialized Docket: Mental Health Court

Led by Judge Annalisa S. Williams

*Created for misdemeanor offenders who have been diagnosed with a severe and persistent mental illness*

### Specialized Docket: Valor Court

Led by Judge Jerry Larson

*Dedicated to defendants with military service involved in the criminal justice system*

### Program: Peace of Mind

Led by Judge Annalisa S. Williams

*Addresses the "thinking" behind criminal behavior and guides women on a new life path*

### Program: Restore Individual Self Empowerment (RISE)

Led by Judge Ron Cable

*Provides resources and support to human trafficking, prostitution and sexual exploitation victims*

## **Peace of Mind Program Wins Statewide Award**

Judge Annalisa S. Williams and the Peace of Mind Program earned the Ohio State Bar Association's (OSBA) 2018 Innovative Court Practices Award. OSBA President Robin Weaver presented Judge Williams with the award on Thursday, September 13, 2018 at the Ohio Judicial Conference Annual Meeting in Columbus. The purpose of the Innovative Court Practices Award is to bring greater visibility to exemplary programs in Ohio's courts and to facilitate the transfer of those programs to other courts in the state.



## **Recovery Court Graduate Earns National Attention**

Marie is an Akron Recovery Court graduate and is employed as a Recovery Coach and on the Akron Recovery Court Team. In April of 2018, WKYC took notice of her journey and filmed Marie as she was introduced to the paramedics who saved her life following an overdose in 2015. The story was then picked up by HeartThreads, a national Facebook page promoting human interest stories and the video about Marie's journey had 400,000 views within 24 hours. We are so proud of Marie and know her future is bright!

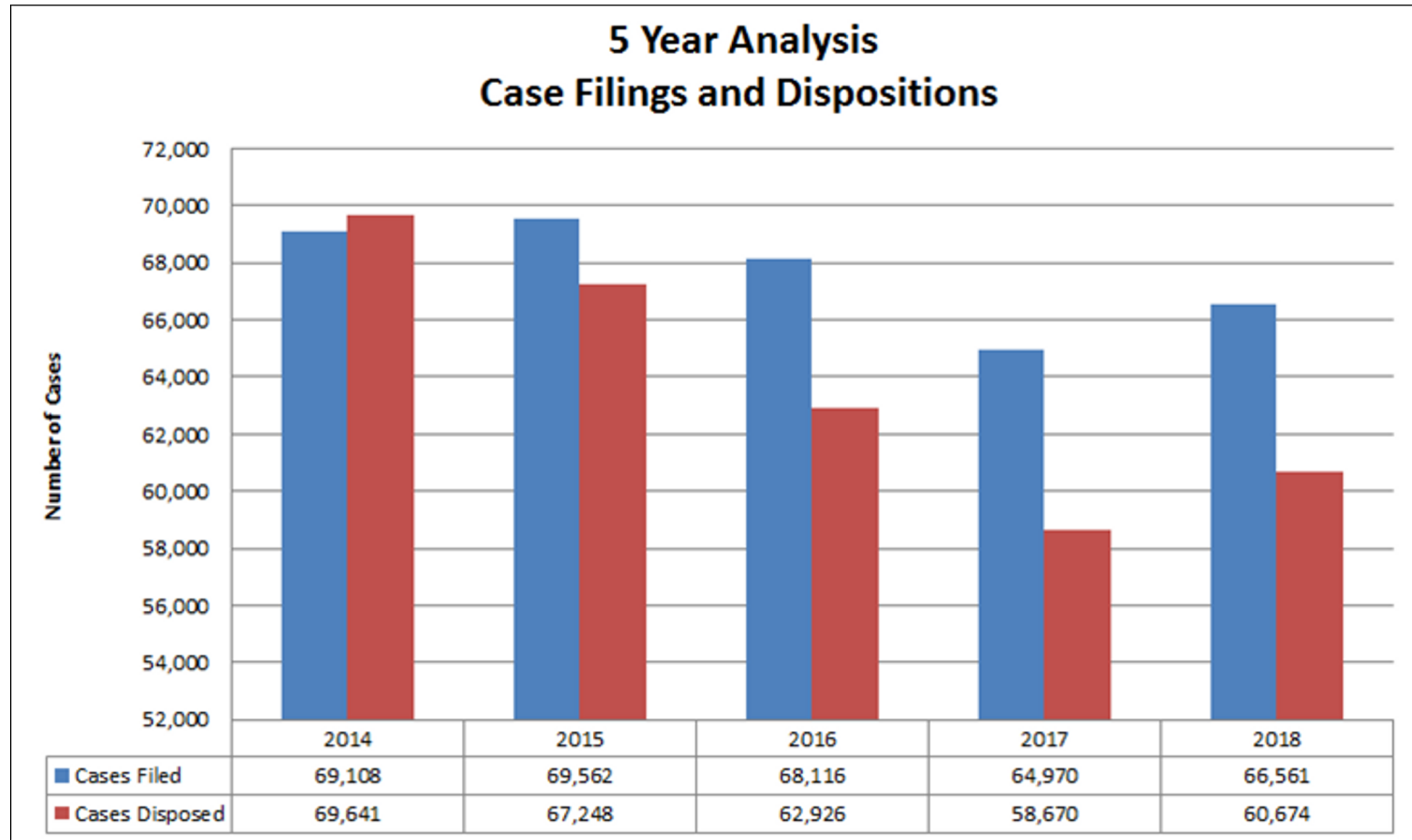


## **Couples Marry At Akron Civic Theatre**

We hosted 284 at the courthouse in 2018 including weddings off-site at the Akron Civic Theatre on Valentine's Day and Halloween.

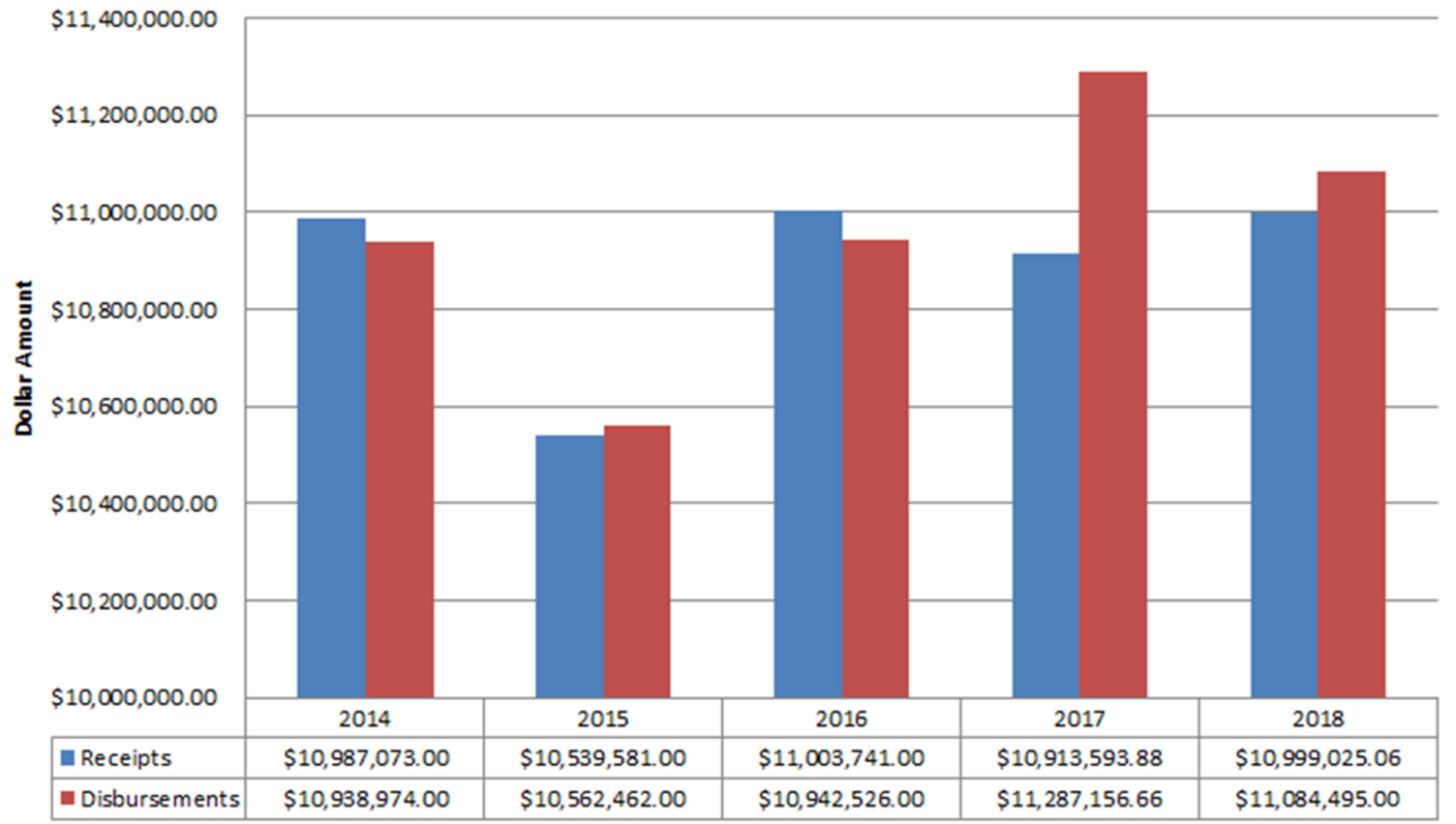

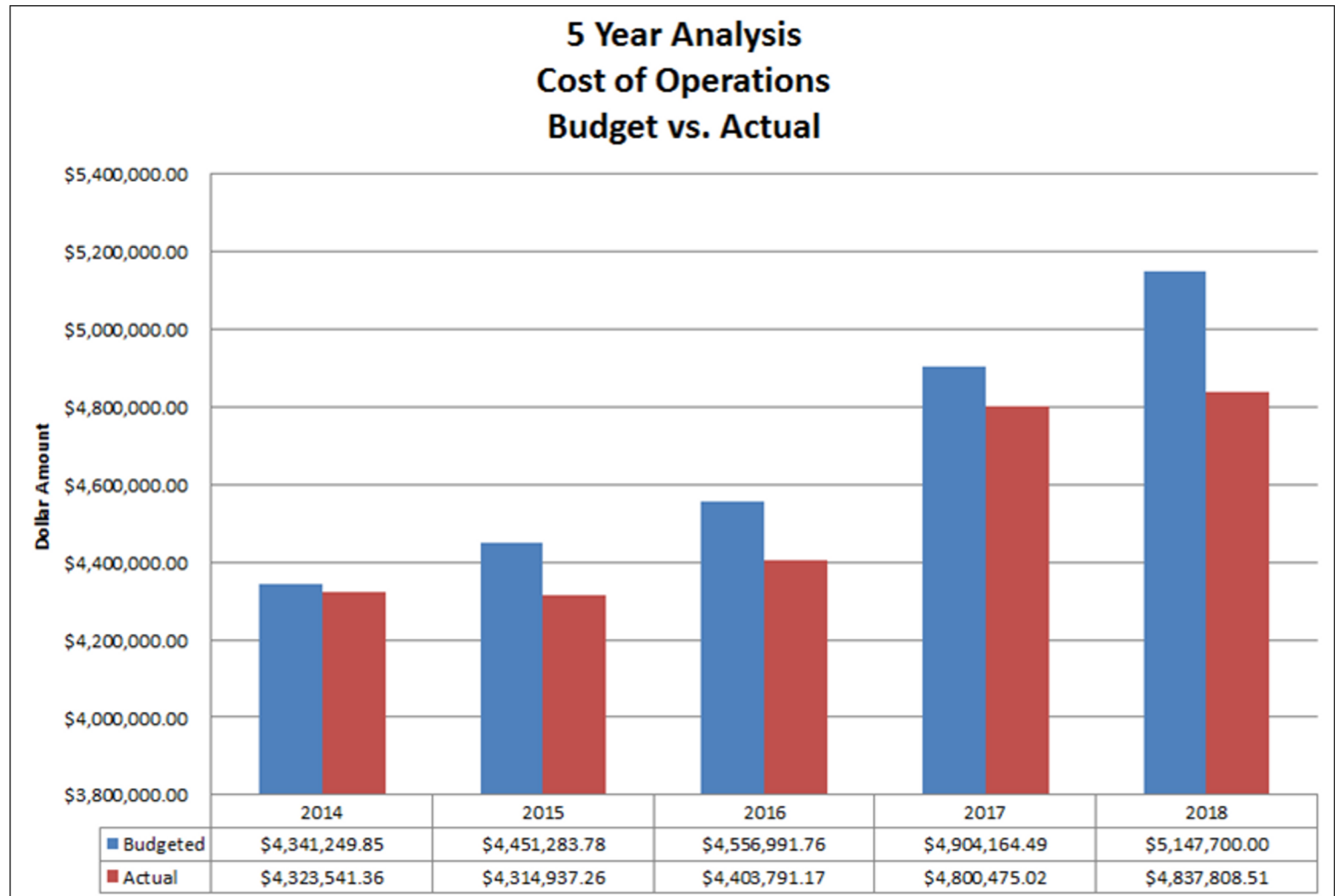
