IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND DECREED THAT, PURSUANT TO THE POTENTIAL FOR CIVIL UNREST IN THE CITY OF AKRON, IT IS THE ORDER OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE JUDGE OF THE COURT THAT ALL ACTIVITIES OF THE AKRON MUNICIPAL COURT BE CONDUCTED IN A REMOTE CAPACITY UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE.

- Akron Municipal Court located at the Stubbs Building was asked to restrict courtroom
  access to the public beginning the week of Monday April 10, 2023, and the building
  was subsequently closed to non-police employees on Friday April 14, 2023 by order of
  the City of Akron.
- 2. The Akron Municipal Court Local Rules may be temporarily adapted to allow Court flexibility, within constitutional limits, in response to the emergency.
- 3. The public emergency may be considered as a finding of good cause for continuances deemed necessary by assigned Judges on a case by case basis.
- 4. The Court will have the lawful authority, within constitutional limits, to do and direct to be done all things necessary to ensure the orderly and efficient administration of justice for the duration of the declared public emergency.
- 5. This order is retroactive to Monday April 10, 2023.

ALL EMPLOYEES SHALL WORK REMOTE UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE FROM THE ADMINISTRATIVE JUDGE.
